make recommendation and select sites for testing species. They suggested Bald Cypress for a specific location on the farm and we planted this tree in 2021. It's a fairly wet area by the pond. Let's see how it likes its new home.

The scientific name for Bald Cypress is Taxodium distichum. It is a deciduous conifer in the family Cupressaceae. It is native to the southeastern United States. Hardy and tough, this tree adapts to a wide range of soil types, whether wet, salty, dry, or swampy. It is noted for the russet-red fall color of its lacy needles.
