




STF—10 May 2023—eBird Trip Report

This trip report to Springboro Tree Farm includes 5 separate eBird lists made by doing a 20 minute stationary observation at each pre-selected observation point for each of the 5 plots established for the project. Observations were made by two observers with binoculars and by identifying singing birds. Observers moved around the stationary point in a 30 foot circle to get clear views.

The Merlin app was used to cross-check audible observations. During this particular set of observations no sound-only identification was made that was not confirmed by Merlin, although that would not be considered a specific required criteria for identification in the future. Observers made an effort to not report individual singing birds in more than one list. In other words a loud Northern Cardinal singing between Plot 2 and Plot 3 was only listed once even though it could be heard in both locations. Soaring birds such as a particular immature bald eagle over the area were only reported once although it was present through several observation periods. Locations provided by the tree farm were converted from DMS to DD for use in eBird. Locations used are:

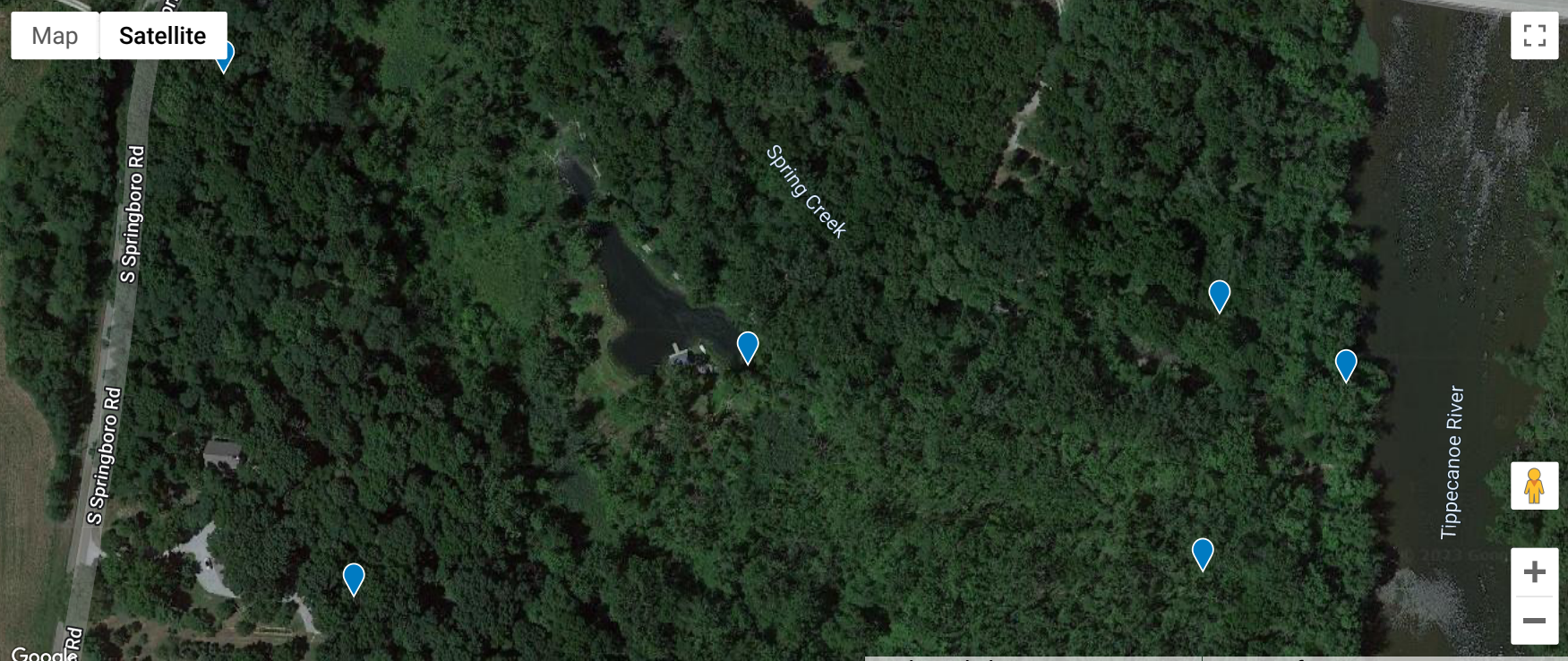
